

## **SLAT 2025 Registration**

### A. Registration process

SLAT 2025 will be conducted on two different dates. Candidates can appear for the dates, i.e. December 13, 2024 (Friday) and December 15, 2024 (Sunday).

A candidate can appear for SLAT on both the dates December 13,2024 (Friday) and December 15,2024 (Sunday). If a candidate appears for more than one test, the higher score will be considered for the final percentile calculation. There will be no normalization. A rigorous process that has been statistically tested will be administered to ensure that unique types of questions are framed under a specific topic across the question papers. The normal spread will ensure that there is no unfair advantage to candidates who opt for any specific test / multiple tests. This will ensure the normalisation of the spread of questions across sections. Furthermore, the question papers will be normalised for the level of difficulty across all two tests. No correspondence regarding this will be entertained.

The registration process is as follows:

- 1. Click on 'Register'.
- 2. Read all the Instructions carefully and then click on the 'Continue' button to accept the Terms and Conditions.
- 3. Fill in the details requested on the page displayed.
- 4. Click on 'Save & Continue'. An OTP will be sent to the mobile number and email id that you have entered.
- 5. Enter the 'OTP' and submit.
- 6. After successful registration, you will get an e-mail & SMS containing your SLAT ID and password. Use this SLAT ID for all communications regarding the SLAT 2025 entrance test / admission procedure.
- 7. Pay the SLAT entrance test registration fee of INR 2250 per test [government taxes would be additional as and when applicable]-non-transferable and non-refundable as per the instructions mentioned on the Registration Portal.
- 8. If you have any queries, please log in to your SLAT ID and click on "Raise A Query" and generate a ticket. Generating a ticket is essential to resolve your query.
- 9. The modes of payment for the programme(s) registration fee is same as that for SLAT.
- 10. Candidate must declare and maintain a valid and unique email account and a mobile phone number throughout the admission process.
- 11. A candidate is required to fill in the correct information in the online registration form which corresponds to her/his credentials.
- 12. Register online on the website <u>www.slat-test.org</u> (upto November 22, 2024 (Friday)). Note: No changes shall be permitted after the registration under any circumstances.
- 13. A candidate can appear for SLAT on both the dates **December 13, 2024 (Friday) and December 15, 2024 (Sunday).** If a candidate appears for more than one test, the higher score will be considered for the final percentile calculation.
- 14. Please also note that if any information provided by a candidate is found to be incorrect, the University shall have right to cancel the candidature of that candidate.

- 1. Upload your latest scanned colour passport size photo at the time of Online Registration. (Your photograph should not be more than 06 months old).
- 2. Ensure that the information you have filled is accurate. No changes shall be permitted after the registration under any circumstances. ## B. Modes of payment

The entrance test registration fee for SLAT is INR 2250/- per test (Non- refundable and non-transferable).

In addition to that, you are also expected to pay the programme registration fee of INR 1000/- for each programme that you wish to apply for. (non-refundable and non-transferable)

- 1. No change of test city requests will be entertained once candidate has completed registration for SLAT 2025. Test City allocation is made based on date of payment for SLAT 2025. The earlier you pay, the higher chances of securing a Test City of your choice.
- 2. It is advisable that candidate decides prior to registration, which test(s) he/she wants to appear for as in a computer-based test, the test Centre capacities are limited.
- 3. The Test Centre and its address will be printed on the Admit Card.
- 4. While all efforts will be made to ensure that the candidate gets a test city as per his/her preferences, however, in some exceptional circumstances, a different test city in a nearby area may be allotted.
- 5. Symbiosis Test Secretariat reserves the right to change or allot a city other than the one requested by the candidate in the event of the requested city not being available for any reason.

## F. Procedure of Programme Payment:

A candidate desirous to submit his candidature to select UG programmes, is also required to complete the payment process of desired programme before the closing date of payment of the same. Payment towards the programmes must be made through the website only (slat-test.org). After making the payment for **SLAT**, proceed to complete the online registration form (Part II) for Programme (s) registration and the respective institute(s). A candidate is required to make separate **non-refundable** and **non-transferable** payment of **INR 1000/- per programme per institute at this stage.** 

If candidates want to pay programme payment through Demand Draft, make Demand Draft of INR 1000/- for **each programme** in the name of "**Symbiosis Test Secretariat**".

Even after closing of the payment for SLAT 2025, a candidate may still pay through website till the last date of payment for the programme(s). An institute may offer more than one programme. A candidate should ensure that the preferred programme(s) is / are selected and paid before the last date.

Indian nationals and NRI candidates shall have to apply under SLAT 2025 to seek admission to the select Undergraduate programmes of Symbiosis International (Deemed University).

After the declaration of the SLAT 2025 result, the institute (offering the programme(s) for which you have paid) will conduct further admission processes for short-listed candidates. The schedule for the same will be published on the website of the respective institute(s).

Any attempt to impersonate or indulge in any malpractice, identified at any stage of the admission process would disqualify the candidate from the admission processes to all UG programmes of Symbiosis International (Deemed University) and may also lead to appropriate legal action as deemed fit.

As per the UGC guideline 2006, the reservation policy for all the institutes under the University is as follows:

- Candidates applying for any of the above-mentioned categories will be required to upload their relevant supporting documents at the time of registration and the same will be verified at the time of PI.
- \* The definition for Children / Wards of Defence Personnel is:

The term Defence Personnel would mean only those serving / retired Defence personnel from Army, Navy, Air Force. Retired defence personnel are those who fall in the category of ex-servicemen as laid down in Ministry of Defence letter no 36035/5/85- Estt (SCT) dated 14 April 1987. It includes children of defence personnel who died while in service or after retirement.

## # Differently Abled Category (DAC) at SIU

In compliance to Government directives on disability guidelines issued by the office of the Chief Commissioner for Persons with Disabilities vide Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, New Delhi notification no. 16-18/97 dated 01st June 2001 and University Grants Commission Notification No. F.6-1/2006 (CPP-II/SCT) dated 30/09/2009, SIU has made provision of reserving 3% seats for Differently Abled Category (DAC) candidates in all the programmes offered by all the Institutes of SIU.

# Differently Abled (DA) candidate means a candidate having any of the disabilities in accordance with the Persons with Disabilities Act - 1995 and as per revised Gazette of India Registered no: DL - (N)04/0007/2003-16 dated December 28,2016.

The types of disabilities covered are: -

- 1. Vision Impairment
- 2. Hearing Impairment
- 3. Locomotor Disabilities
- 4. Mental Retardation
- 5. Multiple Disabilities
- 6. Dyslexia/Dysgraphia/ Dyscalculia

\*Differently Abled (DA) candidate means a candidate having any of the disabilities in accordance with the Persons with Disabilities Act – 1995 and as per revised Gazette of India Registered no: DL – (N)04/0007/2003-16 dated December 28, 2016.

Process to be followed for Differently Abled Candidates (DAC):

- The candidate applying for the entrance examination/admission in the DAC (Differently Abled Category), selects the type of disability available in the DA options on the portal.
- A Differently Abled Category candidate is required to upload his/her copy of Disability Certificate issued by Competent Government Medical Authority the and Unique Disability ID (UD ID) Card at the time of registration for entrance/admission of SIU to ascertain percentage and the type of the disability.
- The Medical Superintendent, SUHRC through Medical Board shall ascertain the genuineness of the said documents. Once the documents are found authentic and correct by the Medical Board, SUHRC, his/her eligibility will be certified under the DA category.

**Note** – If a candidate selects a Differently Abled Category in the Registration form and s/he requires scribe/writer facility please note SIU will not be providing scribe/writer. The candidate has to make her/his own arrangement for scribe/writer. The qualification of scribe/writer should be a maximum 9th standard candidate or a maximum 9th standard passed candidate (Or Appearing 10th Standard). The scribe should not have completed studies beyond the 9th standard. Candidate should send the request to <a href="mailto:info@slat-test.org">info@slat-test.org</a>, on or before November 22,2024 (Friday) in case scribe/writer is required.

During the test, as per SIU Examination norms, a Differently Abled Candidate is provided with 20 minutes of compensatory time for every 60 minutes of the test.

 A candidate applying under any of the reserved category (Scheduled Caste/ Scheduled Tribes/ Differently Abled/ Kashmiri Migrants/ Children/wards of Defence Personnel) are mandatorily required to upload and submit relevant document issued by competent authority. Any participation at any stage of admission process by such candidate is purely provisional and always subject to verification and authentication of such relevant document.

- 2. In case a candidate falls under more than one of the above categories (e.g. Scheduled Caste as well as Differently Abled or any other combination), S/he would need to select any one Category (i.e. Either Scheduled Caste OR Differently Abled in the case of example mentioned above) at the time of filling up the registration form. The category selected by the candidate at the time of filling the registration form will be considered to be his category for the entire admission process and his benefits and entitlements shall be according to such selected category. S/he will not be able to claim benefit under the other category/s at any stage of admission on any account whatsoever.
- 3. Please also note that if any information provided by the candidate in respect of his category is found to be incorrect, the University shall have right to cancel the candidature of such candidate.

# H. Reservation of seats for Nagpur Domicile (SLS, Nagpur) (25% of seats within the sanctioned intake- Only in case of Constituents at Off-Campus center, Nagpur)

In accordance with Clause A of Schedule C of the Lease Deed signed between Nagpur Municipal Corporation, Nagpur and Symbiosis, Pune on 4th September, 2017, the University has reserved 25% seats against the approved intake in each programme offered at the Off-campus Centre of the University at Nagpur for Nagpur Domiciled candidates.

## The definition for Nagpur Domicile is:

Nagpur Domiciled' means candidates, who are domiciled in Nagpur for a period of 5(five) years as on the date of commencement of the academic year and who (a) are or will be graduates or students of Nagpur University, and/or (b) are recipients of school certificates from the Maharashtra State Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education, the Council of Indian School Certificate Examinations, and/or the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE)/ICSE Board.

While giving admission under the Nagpur domicile category-

- Residence Criterion: Resident of Nagpur Urban (five continuous or intermittent years) is mandatory,
- Educational Criterion: The candidate should fulfil one of the following criteria
- (a) graduate or pursuing graduation from Nagpur University
- OR-
- (b) school certificates (10<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup>) from (i) Maharashtra Board, (ii) CISCE (iii) CBSE, (iv) ICSE (It simply means 10<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> passed certificates from other State Boards and foreign school boards are NOT accepted)

#### J. Process for International Candidates:

Admissions of international students are centralized for all the constituent institutes of Symbiosis International Deemed University and are routed through the Symbiosis Centre for International Education (SCIE).

SCIE earmarks 20% of the total intake of the respective program for international students which include, Foreign Nationals (FN), Person of Indian Origin (PIO) Card Holders, Overseas Citizens of India (OCI) Card Holders, and Non-Resident Indians (NRI).

## Foreign National (FN):

A student is eligible to apply as a Foreign National (FN) if he/she is a citizen of any country other than India and holds a foreign passport.

#### Person of Indian Origin (PIO):

As per the Government of India notification dated 9th January 2015, all the existing Persons of Indian Origin cardholders registered as such shall be deemed to be Overseas Citizens of India cardholders.

## **Overseas Citizen of India (OCI):**

A student is eligible to apply as OCI if he/she is granted with Overseas Citizenship of India and has an OCI card.

#### **Non-Resident Indian (NRI):**

A student is eligible to apply as a Non-Resident Indian (NRI) if he/she has appeared for either 10th or 10+2 (equivalent to the Indian 10th or 12th) examination outside India. It is mandatory for one of the two qualifying examinations to be given outside India. Please refer www.scie.ac.in for more details.







- a) Writing sample/subjective/descriptive answer (Writing Sample: two subjective questions for 20 marks each, total 40 marks) for 65 minutes concerning social, political and legal issues.
- b) 10 objective / multiple choice questions for 20 marks relating to general knowledge, legal reasoning and reading comprehension.
- c) Online Psychometric Test of 20 minutes for 10 marks. There will be a time limit to answer the questions. Once the time limit is over, the candidate will lose an opportunity to answer the questions.
- d) An answer given by a candidate will be locked, so the candidate will not be able to change the answer. The candidate needs to ensure that the answer is recorded within the stipulated time limit.
- e) The AIAT (CBT Mode) will be conducted on 15th December 2024

## **Step 3: Online Personal Interaction (PI):**

- There will be a total of 30 marks for PI: Personal Interaction is intended to test the personal attributes, fitment, work experience, global outlook, professionalism, ethics, values, and statement of purpose of a candidate. Each candidate will get a maximum of 6 to 8 minutes for PI. The candidate needs to be ready at the given time without any excuse by following the instructions given by SLS, Pune-SIU.

# Step 2: Symbiosis Law Admission Test (SLAT 2025) - Centre Based Test

Admission to 5 years of BALLB & BBA LLB is offered through the Symbiosis Law Admission Test (SLAT), which consists of:

**SLAT (Centre-Based Test): This comprises** multiple-choice questions to assess General Knowledge, Logical Reasoning, Analytical Reasoning, Basic English and Basic Legal Reasoning. There will be a time limit to answer the questions. Once the time limit is crossed, the candidate will lose the opportunity to answer the questions. The candidate must ensure the answer is recorded within the stipulated time limit. Date for **SLAT (Centre Based Test)**: SLAT 2025 will be conducted on two different dates. Candidates can appear for the dates, i.e. December 13, 2024 (Friday) and December 15, 2024 (Sunday).

After declaring the SLAT result, SLS Hyderabad will publish the list of shortlisted candidates eligible for the PI (Personal Interaction) process.

**Note:** The candidate's name will appear in the list of shortlisted candidates for PI only if he/she has registered and paid (programme-wise fee @Rs.1000/- for each programme) to SLS, Hyderabad, while filling out the SLAT registration form.

# **Step 3: Online Personal Interaction (PI):**

Personal Interaction will be conducted only for the candidates, who appeared and qualified for SLAT Test. Personal Interaction is intended to test the Personal Attributes, inclination toward law as a career, overall personality and communication skills, Extracurricular and Co-curricular activities, and elementary knowledge of the law of a candidate.

- (a) Schedule of Online PI: PI will be conducted online on different dates for SLS Pune, SLS NOIDA, SLS Nagpur, and SLS Hyderabad. Shortlisted candidates will receive a link and instructions 30 minutes prior to the schedule of the online PI.
- **(b) Schedule for SLS Hyderabad Online PI (Personal Interaction):** SLS Hyderabad will conduct Online PI (Personal Interaction as updated on the website. PI will be conducted on different dates. Kindly refer to the 'Important Dates' section on the website.

The candidate shall book a slot for PI at SLS, Hyderabad. The slot booking link for shortlisted candidates will be available on our website, <a href="www.slsh.edu.in">www.slsh.edu.in</a>. If the candidate does not book a slot within the stipulated date and time, a forceful allotment will be made. The candidate needs to check the SLS Hyderabad website for status (shortlisted or not) and to book the slot for PI. The candidate can download the call letter for personal interaction from the SLS Hyderabad website using their login credentials. For the PI of other institutes, please visit their respective websites.




