ADMISSION Process - PGDM (ABM) 2025-27

1. Eligibility: The candidate must hold a Bachelor's Degree in Agriculture Sciences or in Agriculture-related disciplines, with at least 50% marks or equivalent CGPA [45% in case of the candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste (SC)/ Scheduled Tribe (ST), Divyangjan category] of anyof the Universities incorporated by an act of the Central or State legislature in India or other educational institutions established by an Act of Parliament or declared to be deemed as a University under Section 3of UGC Act, 1956, or possess an equivalent qualification recognized by the Ministry of HRD, Government of India or a Bachelor's degree in Agriculture Sciences or Agriculture-related disciplinesrecognized by ICAR. The Bachelor's Degree or equivalent qualification obtained by the candidate mustentail a minimum of three years of education after completing higher secondary schooling (10+2) or equivalent. Agriculture related disciplines shall include: Agriculture, Agri Business Management, Commercial Agriculture, Agricultural Marketing and Cooperation, Agricultural Engineering, AgriculturalInformation Technology, Bioinformatics, Biotechnology, Dairy Technology, Fisheries, Food Technology, Food Processing Engineering, Forestry, Horticulture, Sericulture, Veterinary Science & Animal Husbandry and all other streams of Agriculture and Allied subjects as mentioned in the Diversity Factor Table

(OR)

The candidate must hold at least a Bachelor's degree or equivalent qualification in any other subject like Humanities, Social Sciences, Engineering, Pure Sciences, Commerce etc. with at least 50% marks or equivalent CGPA (45% in case of the candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste (SC)/ Scheduled Tribe (ST), Persons with Disability (PWD) category) from a University or Institution as defined in the above paragraph. The Bachelor's Degree or equivalent qualification obtained by the candidates must entail a minimum of three years of education after completing higher secondary schooling (10+2) or equivalent.

- 2. The candidates must have a valid Score of CAT-2024.
- 3. Reservation of seats will be applicable for OBC (Non-Creamy Layer), SC, ST, Divyangjan, EWS and Kashmiri Migrant categories as per Govt. of India Rules.
- 4. Candidates those are in final year of their graduation can also apply and submit their provisional certificate and mark sheets/grade card indicating up to date and latest cumulative marks/CGPA/OGPA till the previous year/semester and also indicate the same in the application form. Their provisional eligibility will be decided based on the same. If selected, they may seek provisional admission into the program on payment of the required fee and other charges as specified. After joining the program, they will have to submit the provisional degree certificate and aggregate marks/CGPA/OGPA latest by August 31, 2025 failing which the provisional admission will automatically stand cancelled.

- 5. There will be no refund of fee paid by the students, in the event of the cancellation of their admission for the above reasons. All applicants are required to submit attested photocopies of documents along with the application as indicated in the application form. They must produce all original documents for verification at the time of interview and admission.
- 6. It is the responsibility of the candidates to ascertain and ensure that they possess the requisite qualifications for admission. Having been admitted provisionally does not mean acceptance of eligibility. Final eligibility for admission will be decided by CCS NIAM.
- 7. A multi-stage selection procedure will be followed for admission as described below.

 Merit list will be prepared for calling candidates for Group Discussion and Personal Interview based on CAT Score as per the weightage formula mentioned in Multi-Stage Selection Procedure

The merit list will be prepared category wise i.e. General Category, OBC (Non Creamy layer), EWS, SC, ST, PH, Kashmiri Migrants.

Diversity Factor weightage will be assigned to various academic disciplines as per the list given below.

The CAT Score weightage will be computed as per the following formula:

1.	CAT Score (CS)	CS = (Candidate's CAT Score / Highest CAT Score) * 51

The candidates who has CAT score should mention in the appropriate column provided in the application form. Based on the above formula whichever score is advantageous to the candidate will be used to determine the merit in the selection process.

Candidates shall be called for group discussion, personal interview and other testing parameters based on CAT Score for different categories. Cut off for CAT score will be decided after last date of filling of application depending on number of applications received. Registration fees will not be refunded to any candidates.

Personal interview and Group Discussion may include subjects to test candidate's aptitude for Agriculture and Management. Candidate's record in extracurricular activities and any additional qualifications or accomplishments may also be considered during the interview process.

Work Experience weightage shall be awarded as per the following plan.

0.5 marks extra shall be awarded for each year's job experience in agriculture & allied sectors and in rural development with an upper ceiling of 5 marks in work Experience.

The final merit rank list will be based on the summation of points earned in all the assessment items mentioned above.

Application Form

Online application form can be filled on the website www.ccsniam.gov.in. Candidates required to upload photograph, digital signature, all relevant documents along with category certificate if candidate belongs to any category. Registration fees of Rs. 1200/- (Rs. 600/- for SC and ST Candidates) to be paid through online gateway only from NIAM online application form Application without registration fee will not be considered. Once online application form is submitted, it will not allow to edit it. However, applicants will get a chance to upload their CAT score card once CAT result is announced, if the applicant has not uploaded the score. Application and Fees received after last date and time will not be considered.


